The final admission is subject to fulfilment of the minimum eligibility requirement of the respective programme along with fulfilling the other admission rules of the University of Delhi.
- 2. Admission in MBA (BA/HRD/IB) programmes shall be provisional and subject to physical verification of the documents on the day of counselling. At the time of counselling the candidates are required to produce all the original documents. The marksheet or equivalent document must clearly state the maximum marks and marks obtained for all subjects for X and XII. In case any discrepancy is found in the physical verification of the documents or the required documents are not produced, the candidature of such applicant shall be liable to cancellation and the candidate cannot claim his/her admission.
- 3. In case of tie in the ranks, tiebreakers in the following order of preference (as approved in the Commerce and Business Courses Admission Committee) have been applied while preparing the merit list:
  - Candidates with higher CAT Score have been given preference.

• Candidates having higher aggregate marks (all subjects) in the class XII Board examination have been given preference.

• Candidates having higher aggregate marks (all subjects) in the class X Board examination have been given preference.

Candidates having higher age have been given preference.
